Core Responsibilities:

The primary agricultural conditioning, packing, and export entity in the country. The company specializes in transforming fresh bananas from the tree into export-ready Cavendish bananas through a fumigation process that applies fungicides and a cicatrization protector, helping preserve their quality during storage and transportation. The bananas are then packed into new corrugated carton boxes with lids. Each box includes internal cardboard protection and a polyethylene vacuum-sealed bag to safeguard the product at its ideal ripening stage. **AgroGestaEC** ensures consistent quality by performing agricultural quality control at origin and producing SGS-certified Cavendish bananas that meet international standards for volume and traceability.



AGROGESTAMINERALIA S.A.S.

AgroGestaMineralia S.A.S. oversees responsible mineral sourcing at origin, ensuring that all products - including gold and its derivatives - meet strict quality and traceability standards.

If exporter makes in the trade of primary agricultural products (such as edible grains, oil seeds, spices, coffee beans, etc), live animals & plants, animal feeds (including pet food), etc., the exporter also need to apply the export to China "GACC WhiteList" before exporting to China.
